
ALARMS

The Multi-Frequency back-up alarm provides a solution to potential noise pollution created by conventional back-up alarms in confined or densely populated work areas. The Multi-Frequency alarm maintains a safe warning signal for those in the danger zone of backing vehicles while minimising disturbance to work site neighbours. The Multi-Frequency alarm operates by emitting sound at multiple frequencies attenuated above 4000Hz. In addition, driver technology used in the EA6100, EA7020, EA7070, EA9070, EA9724, and EA9780 models extends the life expectancy of the alarm, so much so, that a life of the vehicle warranty is offered.
